KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

WHAT IS ALBERTA NETCARE?

To help make decisions about your care quickly and efficiently, your health information is available through a province-wide electronic record system named Alberta Netcare, under the authority of the *Health Information Act*.

YOUR RIGHTS:

Consent to have your health information included in Alberta Netcare is **not required** by law, but **you** have **six rights** that allow you to exercise **privacy control**.

YOU HAVE THE RIGHT TO...

1 KNOW WHY YOUR HEALTH INFORMATION IS COLLECTED

2 ASK FOR A COPY OF YOUR ALBERTA NETCARE RECORD

3 LIMIT ACCESS TO YOUR ALBERTA NETCARE RECORD

4 KNOW WHO HAS LOOKED AT YOUR INFORMATION IN ALBERTA NETCARE

5 ASK THAT ERRORS BE CORRECTED

6 ASK FOR AN INDEPENDENT REVIEW
